Education and integration under one roof: Municipal Education and Integration Centre (KoBIZ) Euskirchen District

The KoBIZ is a department of the district administration. The fields of activity of the Regional Education Office (RBB), the Municipal Integration Centre (KI) and the Municipal Coordination Office for the Transition from School to Career (KoKo) for the state project "No Graduation without Continuation" (KAoA) are summarised here.

KoKo is the central office for implementing the "No Graduation without Continuation" (KAoA) process.

It is the driving force on the ground, coordinating the actors and their activities, such as schools and school supervisors, the Federal Employment Agency (Agentur für Arbeit), professional associations (Kammern), trade unions, employers' associations and other organisations. Its aim is to work together with all partners to individually guide each pupil in the transition from school to career in accordance with their needs.


